## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INCOMING GRADE VII

Must accomplish and submit the following on June 15, 2020 to the Principal's Office:

- a. Application Form (download the form)
- b. Personal letter of application both by the applicant student and his/her parents;
- c. Clear photocopy of Form 138 (Report Card);
- d. Photocopy of the Latest Income Tax Return (Family's total gross income from all sources must not exceed Php 200,000) or Certificate of Tax Exemption or Municipal Certification of Unemployment of Parents/Legal Guardian; and
- e. Certification of Good Moral Character attesting that the applicant has no disciplinary record and must be of good moral character from:
  - i. school last attended
  - ii. barangay
  - iii. religious leader where the applicant is affiliated in or belongs

**Note:** Must not be a recipient of any other scholarship grant, and in the event the grantee qualifies for an Academic Honor, the corresponding honor attached to it shall be conferred on the student through a University Certificate in lieu of any monetary consideration.

## **APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS**

The applicant must be an incoming Grade VIII, Grade IX or Grade X student of the Junior High School of the School of Basic Education.

Must accomplish and submit the following on June 15, 2020 to the Principal's Office:

- a. Application Form (download the form)
- b. Personal letter of application both by the applicant student and his/her parents;
- c. Clear photocopy of Form 138 (Report Card) with an average grade of at least 85% with no grade below 80% in any subject and any grading period;
- d. Photocopy of the Latest Income Tax Return (Family's total gross income from all sources must not exceed PhP 200,000) or Certificate of Tax Exemption or Municipal Certification of Unemployment of Parents/Legal Guardian; and
- e. Certification of Good Moral Character attesting that the applicant has no disciplinary record and must be of good moral character from
  - i. barangay
  - ii. religious leader where the applicant is affiliated in or belongs

Note: Must not be a recipient of any other scholarship grant, and in the event the grantee qualifies for an Academic Honor, the corresponding honor attached to it shall be conferred on the student through a University Certificate in lieu of any monetary consideration.
