## Transfiguration Sunday

Transfiguration Sunday marks the event narrated by the gospels when the appearance of Jesus became transfigured before the very sight of his own disciples. His face appeared so bright as if shining in the sun while his clothes appeared so dazzling white (Matthew 17:2). His over-all appearance before his disciples was like one who has become a heavenly, angelic figure and standing even in the company of well known biblical figures such as

Moses and Elijah. Here, Jesus is being seen and identified as one who is worthy of being exalted, glorified as truly the Son of God. As the voice from heaven declares: "This is my son, my beloved, with whom I am well pleased; listen to him." This is certainly an event in our faith history that is worth celebrating as it affirms the sole Lordship of the one whom we recognize as the Messiah and Savior of the world and whose voice is the only one we should listen to.



This coming Wednesday (March 6) is Ash Wednesday in our Church calendar. It is observed to signify to beginning of the season of Lent which will then lead us to the last week of the life and ministry of our Lord Jesus culminating in his death on the cross and eventual

resurrection on Easter Sunday. The symbolism of ash reminds the worshipper of the frailty and mortality of human and earthly existence. We live our lives only for a certain period of time. We are just a passing entity on this earth and will eventually return to ashes and dust. It is a short, passing existence, easily subject to death and decay at any moment. This life therefore has to be lived always in the spirit of humility and with the consciousness of our total and complete dependence only on the power and grace of our God who is the giver and author of all life.
