## Course Description

### **PSYCH 200 SYSTEMS & THEORIES IN PSYCHOLOGY** 3units

Traces the origin and development of modern psychology. A historical perspective of the different schools of thought and the major waves in psychology with a special focus on the contributions of the great leaders of psychology throughout the century. Aims to help the students evaluate the significance and relevance of the various trends in psychology to present time.

### **PSYCH 201 ADVANCED RESEARCH METHODS I** 3units

Deals on the principles, techniques and procedures of research. Involves the formulation of a research design that outlines the scheme of variables, sampling design, data gathering plan, and plan for data analysis.

### **PSYCH 202 ADVANCED STATISTICS I** 3units

### **PSYCH 203 GROUP THERAPY** 3units

Self discovery within a group. Personal growth and group growth based on self-disclosure and group feedback.

### **PSYCH 210 ADVANCED INDUSTRIAL PSYCHOLOGY** 3units

Application of the principles of human behavior in industrial setting. Includes the theories and principles of motivation, group process, communication, leadership behavior and conflict management.

### **PSYCH 214 SEMINAR IN GROUP PROCESS & PROCEDURES** 3units

Theories and principles on the management and direction of groups. Includes procedures of group discussion, training needs analysis, planning and design, implementation and evaluation.

### **PSYCH 218 ORGANIZATIONAL BEHAVIOR & DEVELOPMENT** 3units

Focuses on individual and situational variables, individual and group behavior in an organization. Includes organizational theories, organizational development technologies and organizational change.

### **PSYCH 220 ADVANCED SOCIAL PSYCHOLOGY** 3units

Provides a solid framework of the classic studies and theories as well as new directions and principles about the interactive influence of groups and individual behavior.

### **PSYCH 222 ENVIRONMENTAL PSYCHOLOGY** 3units

Studies the interrelationship between human behavior and experiences and the built and natural environment.

### **PSYCH 224 FILIPINO PSYCHOLOGY** 3units

Discusses the development of psychological thought in the Philippines, core concepts and methodologies in Filipino psychology, issues and trends in indigenous psychology.

<b>PSYCH 226 COGNITIVE PSYCHOLOGY</b>	<b>3units</b>
Emphasizes the way information is processed; presents some of the basic concepts about the way people think and how people organize and then use information.	
<b>PSYCH 228 ADVANCED THEORIES OF PERSONALITY</b>	<b>3units</b>
Intensive study of the psychological foundations of personality; a comparison of the various theoretical approaches to understanding personality and human behavior.	
<b>PSYCH 232 ATTITUDE AND OPINION MEASUREMENT</b>	<b>3units</b>
Focuses on the several ways of measuring attitudes and opinions, their applications and limitations.	
<b>PSYCH 234 GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT</b>	<b>3units</b>
Examines, from a gender perspective, the shift from dependency on natural resources and traditional behavior patterns associated with a rural social order to industrial production for a world market, which calls for new standards of literacy, technical skills, incentives and entrepreneurship. Assesses how modernization in the Third World has brought about gender inequities and disturbances in the family and community.	
<b>PSYCH 235 INTRODUCTION TO WOMEN'S STUDIES</b>	<b>3units</b>
<b>PSYCH 236 QUALITATIVE RESEARCH I</b>	<b>3units</b>
Discusses alternative research methodologies and gender-sensitive research techniques designed to uncover information that direct questioning and observation approaches cannot readily generate.	
<b>PSYCH 238 PROJECTIVE TECHNIQUES</b>	<b>3units</b>
Assessment techniques beyond the performance and paper-and-pencil tests. Focuses on tests or techniques for revealing hidden motives or underlying personality structure of an individual by the use of such materials as ink blots, TAT, etc.	
<b>PSYCH 240 SPECIAL TOPICS IN INDUSTRIAL/ORGANIZATIONAL PSYCH</b>	<b>3units</b>
Discusses the current issues, patterns and trends in industrial/organizational psychology as reported in recent scientific journals, research papers and conferences of professional organizations.	
<b>PSYCH 242 INTRO TO COMMUNITY-BASED RESOURCE MGMT</b>	<b>3units</b>
Entails the process of defining, understanding and identifying approaches in securing and sustaining people's participation in the management of local resources through case studies and field observations.	
<b>PSYCH 244 SPECIAL TOPICS IN SOCIAL AND COMMUNITY PSYCHOLOGY</b>	<b>3units</b>
Discusses the current issues, patterns and trends in social and community psychology as reported in recent scientific journals, research papers and conferences of professional organizations.	

<b>PSYCH 248 DISASTER MANAGEMENT</b>	<b>3units</b>
Focuses on disaster management issues; guidelines for the formulation of disaster management plans and devising mitigation strategies, with an emphasis on the social psychological perspective.

<b>PSYCH 272 PRINCIPLES &amp; ORGANIZATION OF GUIDANCE SERVICES</b>	<b>3units</b>
Deals with the role and function of a guidance program in an institution. Types of organizational set-up, program identification, personnel requirement, and other logistical concerns will be examined.	
<b>PSYCH 274 ADVANCED PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT</b>	<b>3units</b>
Intensive and extensive study of the principles and methods of administering, scoring, and interpreting tests for measuring mental ability, aptitude, interests, educational achievement and personality.	
<b>PSYCH 278 MARRIAGE AND FAMILY THERAPY</b>	<b>3units</b>
A systems approach to the diagnosis and treatment of an individual's problems; views marital and family dynamics as important considerations in handling problem cases.	

<b>PSYCH 280 SEMINAR IN CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY</b>	<b>3units</b>
Introduction to the branch of psychology dealing with the diagnosis and treatment of personality and behavioral disorders.	
<b>PSYCH 281 FEMINIST THERAPY</b>	<b>3units</b>
<b>PSYCH 283 ALTERNATIVE THERAPIES: ART, MUSIC AND PLAY</b>	<b>3units</b>
<b>PSYCH 288 HYPNOSIS AND HYPNOTHERAPY</b>	<b>3units</b>
Deals with the nature, principles and introduction of hypnosis as a technique of therapy.
