Fifth Sunday After Epiphany

As we enter the 5th Sunday after Epiphany we recall the early days of the ministry of Jesus calling his disciples to join and follow him and become fishers of people. His act of calling Peter in Luke 5:1-11 reminds us of the need for everyone to take seriously his call to “Launch into the deep...” if we are to fill the “empty nets” of our own lives.

Jesus calls us to follow him into the deep emptiness of our world and our neighbors. Stretching out the net of his saving love. And even though we must acknowledge—like Simon Peter—that we are often imperfect fisherfolk, we trust that when we push into the deep, it is Jesus who will fill the nets, just as he did for Peter that morning.

The German martyr Dietrich Bonhoeffer famously said:
Only he who believes is obedient, and only he who is obedient believes ... The first step of obedience makes Peter leave his nets ... Only this new existence, created through obedience, can make faith possible. (The Cost of Discipleship)
