## First Sunday in Lent

Journeying with the Heroes  
of Faith in the Bible:



In this season of Lent, as we begin to engage in moments of meditation and reflection on the meaning of this season for our faith understanding we choose to journey with some characters closely associated with the life journey too of our own Lord Jesus.

Today, on the first Sunday of Lent, we give focus on one very important biblical character without whom God's plan for the redemption of the world would not have materialized, Mary.

Mary is a woman admired for her courage and loved for her devotion to God. She walked a difficult path, knowing how costly her total submission to God's plan for her would be. God chose Mary for what could arguably be the most important job in history – bringing our Savior Jesus Christ into the world. She was the perfect unlikely choice, which made her story even more remarkable.

The virgin birth of her son Jesus defied scientific logic. We know the angel Gabriel visited Mary to bring her the news of God's plan. She would give birth, even though she wasn't married yet. Indeed, she can be considered as a model of obedience and submission to God's will even at the cost of her own honor and reputation. She became a mother who have to let go of her Son in order to follow His own calling to be the Savior and Light of the world. She became a mother who witnessed her son Jesus grow in wisdom, stature and maturity in faith. She also witnessed her son being crucified and dying on the cross. Mary went through one of the most painful and agonizing ordeals a mother can ever experience. But she persevered and never gave up her loyalty and devotion to God. She is indeed a model of authentic faith and obedience for everyone who desires to follow and serve our Lord Jesus Christ.
