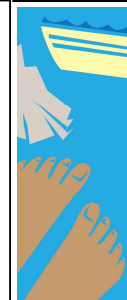

Second SUNDAY OF LENT

On this second Sunday of Lent, we continue deriving lessons and inspiration from characters in the Gospels who had journeyed with Jesus on his way to Calvary. Today, we focus on the very unique character of Simon of Cyrene, based on Mark 15:21 who by his place of origin must be a foreigner and who was actually

just a passer-by as described in the text. As he watched the procession of soldiers escorting Jesus with the cross towards Calvary, he was drawn to come closer to see the man they were about to crucify. Somehow, circumstances forced Simon of Cyrene to carry a cross not his own and share in the pain and suffering that were not meant for him. He was actually compelled to take over the task being undertaken by Jesus, bearing the cross all the way to Calvary.

There could also be times in our experiences when circumstances would call us to respond to carry the cross of others, just to provide a little relief to the burden bearer. It was bearing and sharing in the suffering of others. This becomes so meaningful when the cross of suffering that we help carry is the cross borne by others whom we love. This becomes the ultimate test of Jesus' own teaching to his disciples, that we love one another and that, "Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends." Jesus considers us all as his friends, all worth sacrificing for. It therefore behooves us all to treat also each other, both strangers and the neighbor, either acquainted with us or alienated from us as friends worth sacrificing for, and whose suffering and crosses we would be willing to share all in the spirit of love and kinship under one Father and Savior God.

Buckle up!

Republic Act 11229, which was signed into law last February 22 and published in newspapers last March 12, 2019 is set to be implemented 15 days after notice. This law, the Child Safety in Motor Vehicles Act, requires owners of vehicles to use car seats for babies, not allow children who are below 12 years old in the front seat. Safety of infants and children should be ensured when riding vehicles. Thus traffic-related deaths and injuries in this vulnerable group can be prevented.
