

**Master of Divinity
Major in Pastoral Ministry
[Non-thesis track]**

The Master of Divinity is a graduate professional degree. It is the first level professional theological degree designed for those who already have a baccalaureate degree. Normally, the program consists of three-year academic work and one year supervised internship. All Master of Divinity candidates must maintain a QPA 2.5. All candidates must also pass the comprehensive examinations to qualify for graduation. The comprehensive examination is intended to gauge the capability of the candidate to integrate all the learning experiences in the field of biblical studies, history, theology and ethics, study of religions, practical ministries and Christian education. The comprehensive examination has written and oral components and it will be administered at least two months before the graduation.
