

QR Gate Scan



1. Scan this QR Code using your phone's camera. For Android users, you may use "Google Lens" in case your camera is unable to detect the image.

You may also proceed to the gate to scan the QR Code posted in that area.

2. Agree to the consent page and then fill out the form. If you are at the gate, you may use the thermal scanner to know the temperature you need to enter into the form. If you are at home, you have to use your own thermal scanner or thermometer.



3. After clicking “Submit”, your personal QR Code will be generated. Please take a screenshot or save the image. This will serve as your QR pass and will be valid for seven days.



4. Please present the pass every time you enter the campus gates. The triage personnel assigned in the area will scan your QR Code for validation.
