**Note:** The above subjects must be taught to account the learning device of Wolfgang Goethe that says: "look for the thing behind the phenomena, that is what is learnable" or to account what Lao Tzu proclaims as one of the five methods of handling public affairs: "...to perceive the subtle" or in Ps 119:130: "The unfolding of thy words give light; it imparts understanding to the simple," because those learning methods explain what "strategic thinking" is all about — the engagement of the learner in the "laboratory of possibilities" to generate genuine features of the environment for sound strategy formulation.

#### **Policy Guidelines (PG)**

- 1.0 A student applicant who graduated (with thesis) from the degree of Master in Public Administration, Master of Business Administration, Master of Arts (major in Political Science or Philosophy), Master of Arts in Philosophy, and Master of Arts in Basic Education major in Administration, maybe eligible for admission to the Doctor of Philosophy in Public Administration, subject to the requirements of the Bridging Course of not more than 12 units in the Master of Public Administration, Silliman University. However, if the said student fails to obtain a **satisfactory rating** in at least 6 units of the 12-unit "Bridging Course", he/she is not eligible for admission to the Ph.D. in PA.
- 2.0 A student applicant who graduated Master of Arts or Master of Science outside of the degree/s stated in PG 1.0 is eligible for admission **only** to the Doctor of Public Administration (DPA) of the School of Public Affairs and Governance. The rules on "Bridging Courses" shall apply.
- 3.0 Only the first batch for SPAG-DPA-students maybe allowed to convert their DPA program, or maybe permitted to shift, to the Doctor of Philosophy in Public Administration (Ph.D. in PA) because the contents of their DPA curriculum at this time are similar to the contents of the PH.D. in PA.
